

Neonatal Adult Paediatric Safe Transfer & Retrieval Course (NAPSTaR)

All patients are vulnerable during the preparation and the challenges posed in the actual transferring are substantial from both clinical and non-clinical aspects. In recent years, following concerns about the standard of Head Injury transfers there has been a great deal of interest in improving standards of both the transportation of critically ill patients between hospitals and the transfer of seriously ill patients within a hospital.

In the same way that the ABCDE approach to resuscitation is an excepted systematic approach, the ACCEPT system offers a structured approach to transfer medicine for Healthcare professionals and healthcare organisations

To minimize the risks associated with transfers and to respond successfully to the challenge of a transfer, the NAPSTaR course utilises the **ACCEPT** process as an approach to neonatal, adult and paediatric transfers and provides candidates the knowledge of the processes involved in the transportation of these patients, emphasising the planning and preparation prior to transfer

Using the **ACCEPT** approach of **A**ssessment - **C**ontrol - **C**ommunication - **E**valuation - **P**ackaging - **T**ransportation will substantially improve patient care during both interhospital and intra-hospital transfers.
